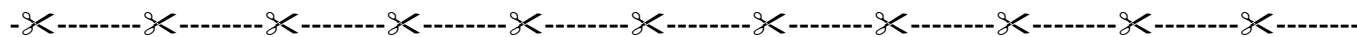
Areas covered in this course include:
